Dear Friend

The Wounded Warrior Run supports a 25 year old Manitoba reservist, Corporal Mackenzie (Mac) MacLeod who will run from Dauphin Manitoba to Winnipeg (440 km), to raise awareness of the contribution of all Canadian Troops serving in Afghanistan and in particular those who are based in Manitoba.

The project will raise funds for a number of Family Support Groups of Manitoba Military Units who provide assistance and support to our troops while they are deployed overseas or are in repatriation enroute home. The event will take place over a 9 day period starting on Canada Day, the 1st of July 2010 from Dauphin Manitoba and finish in Winnipeg's Assiniboine Park on Friday July 9th, Manitobans will be invited to walk along with the runner at each town along the route.
