



Wounded Warrior Run



The project will support 25 year old Cpl. Mackenzie (Mac) MacLeod, a Manitoba reservist who will run from Dauphin Manitoba to Winnipeg (440 km) to raise awareness of the sacrifice and service of Canadian Troops deployed in Afghanistan and those who are based in Manitoba.

The effort will raise funds for Military Family Support Groups who provide assistance to our troops deployed overseas and their families here at home. The event will take place starting on **Canada Day July 1st, 2010** and finish in Winnipeg on **Friday the 9th**.

We are asking for support from all Manitobans to help our troops.

The project is organized entirely by volunteers. The Fort Garry Horse Foundation is providing the administrative support at no cost.

"Mac's Marathon" will begin at the city of Dauphin on Canada Day. Manitobans are invited to jog with the runner at each town throughout the following route: **July 1st: Dauphin, July 2nd: Ste Rose du Lac, July 3rd: McCreary, July 4th: Neepawa, July 5th: Minnedosa, July 6th: Brandon, July 7th: Gladstone, July 8th: Portage La Prairie, July 9th: Headingly to Assiniboine Park Winnipeg. Total: 440 KM**
